Freedom Academy

Our 15 Freedom Academy students had a successful year with their horse. So many accomplishments were made while mounted and unmounted: putting a halter on, learning how to lead, how to get their horse to and from their stall and paddock, how to lunge and free lunge, how to ride, hoof care, dental care, chiropractic, stretches, which blanket to put on for what temp, understanding horses need care every day even when its below zero, how to treat different conditions, and my favorite; learning and understanding free will.

We had dedicated volunteers in the arena with our students September through June 7th. These volunteers were so caring and understanding to each student. Their loving encouragement on the hard days helped our students feel understood. Their beautiful hearts filled the arena every day.

It exposed the students to high-tech electronics assembly and distribution operations and other jobs that go with the industry. The students were shown the skills and schooling required to fill these positions. They loved the hands-on learning. The students were able to interact with front line workers, technicians, analysts, engineers, and other support personnel.

The horses gently guide them as they learn the 'yuk' does not define them. They leave with a new understanding of hope and are so very grateful for their time with the horses.
